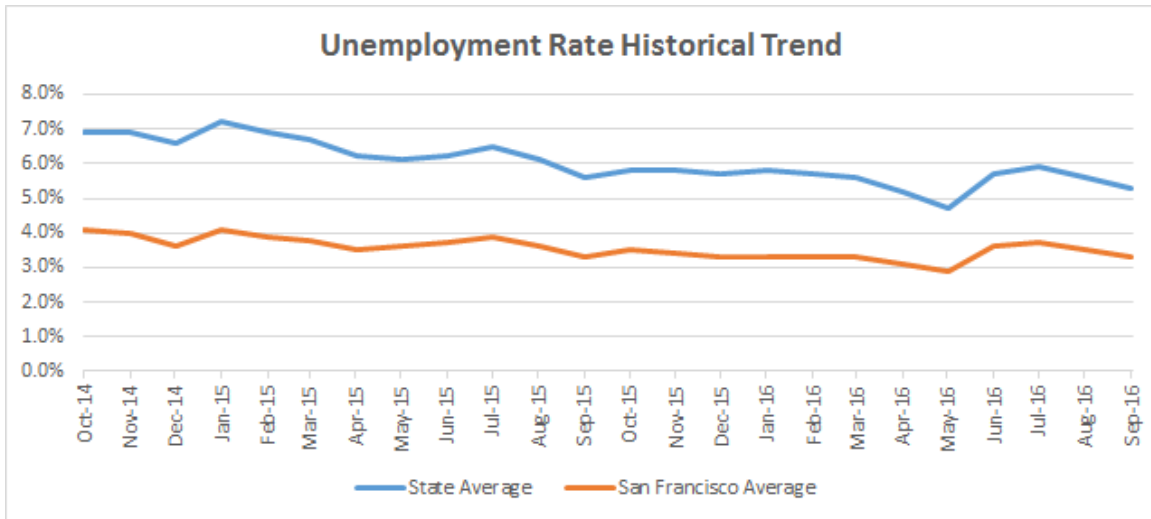




## Labor Market Information

## Current Industry Employment Highlights

- The number of jobs in San Francisco and San Mateo counties increased 2.58 percent between Sept. 2015 and Sept. 2016, and .358 percent between August 2016 and Sept. 2016.
- Of the major industries, construction and professional and business services displayed the highest job growth between September 2015 and September 2016, while other services (comprised of personal and laundry services and religious organizations) and manufacturing were the only two major sectors to show job loss during this period.
- The San Francisco/South San Francisco/Redwood City metropolitan statistical area has an unemployment rate of 3.2 percent, compared with 4.1 percent for San Jose/Sunnyvale, 5.2 percent for Sacramento/Roseville/ Arden/Arcade, 5.2 percent for Los Angeles/Long Beach/Glendale, and 4.7 percent for San Diego/ Carlsbad.
- San Francisco County and San Mateo County continue to have the lowest unemployment rates of all California counties, with unemployment rates of 3.3 percent and 3.1 percent, respectively.
