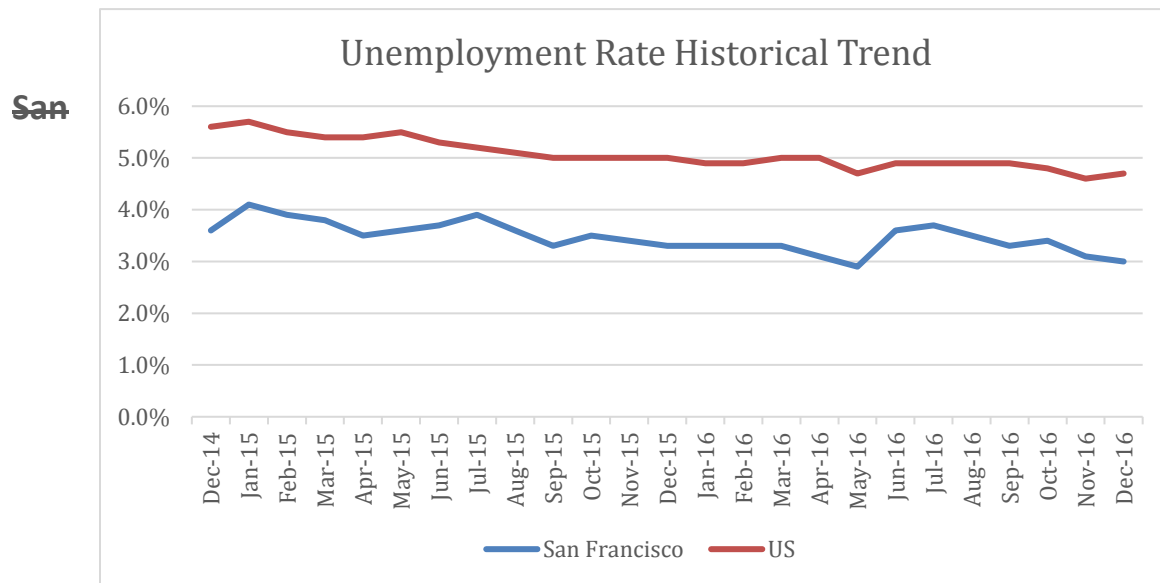




## Labor Market Information

### Current Industry Employment Highlights

- The number of jobs in San Francisco and San Mateo counties increased 1.9 percent between Dec. 2015 and Dec. 2016. The total number of jobs in the San Francisco-Redwood City-South San Francisco MD, which includes the counties of San Francisco and San Mateo, increased by 100 jobs to total 1,103,000.
- Of the major industries, professional business services displayed the highest job growth between December 2015 and December 2016, while manufacturing, information, educational and health services and leisure and hospitality were four major sectors to show job loss during this period.
- The San Francisco/South San Francisco/Redwood City metropolitan statistical area has a lowest unemployment rate of 2.8 percent, compared with 2.9 percent of San Rafael MD, 3.4 percent for San Jose/Sunnyvale, 4.9 percent for Sacramento/Roseville/Arden/Arcade, 4.7 percent for Los Angeles/Long Beach/Glendale, and 4.2 percent for San Diego/ Carlsbad.
