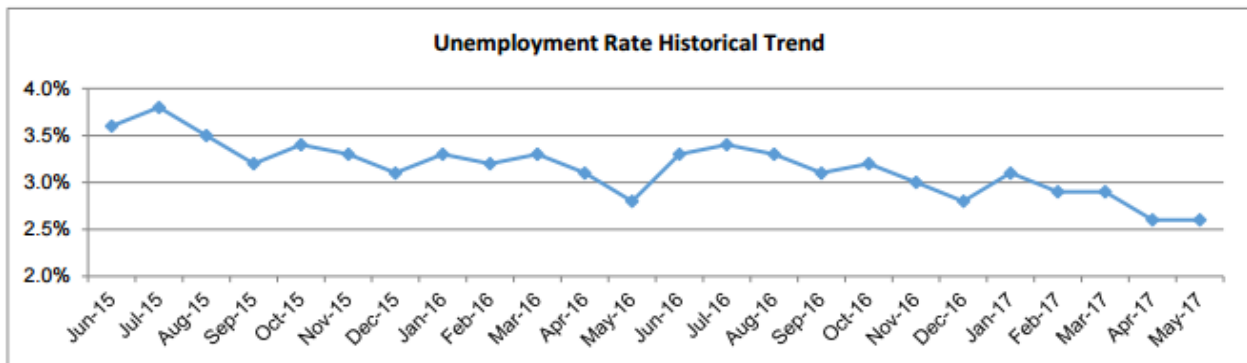

Current Industry Employment Highlights

- The unemployment rate in the San Francisco-Redwood City-South San Francisco MD was 2.6 percent in May 2017, unchanged from a revised 2.6 percent in April 2017, and below the year ago estimate of 2.8 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.2 percent for California and 4.1 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 2.7 percent in San Francisco County.
- Between April 2017 and May 2017, the total number of jobs in the San Francisco-Redwood City-South San Francisco MD, which includes the counties of San Francisco and San Mateo, increased by 800 jobs to reach 1,114,100, the highest total for May on record going back to 1990
- Between May 2016 and May 2017, the total number of jobs in the counties of San Francisco and San Mateo grew by 24,300 jobs, or 2.2 percent
